

Appeal to Use 2022 Parental* Income Information for the 2023/2024 Academic Year

Purpose of this form:

Students whose parent(s) have experienced significant changes in income from 2021 to 2022 may appeal to have 2022 tax information utilized instead of 2021 for calculation of institutional funding eligibility.

To submit your appeal:

1. Complete this form.
2. Submit this form along with a copy of your parent(s) 2022 completed tax return(s). Appeals will not be considered without completed tax returns.
