

## Appeal to Use 2016 Parental\* Income Information for the 2017/2018 Academic Year

### Purpose of this form:

Students whose parent(s) have experienced significant changes in income from 2015 to 2016 may appeal to have 2016 tax information utilized instead of 2015 for calculation of institutional funding eligibility.

### To submit your appeal:

1. Complete this form.
2. Submit this form along with a copy of your parent(s) 2016 completed tax return(s). Appeals will not be considered without completed tax returns.
