

To 4th year medical students receiving financial aid:

Because our office must disburse your Federal Direct Loans in equal amounts over your four quarters of enrollment, **loans funds you receive in summer 2014 may need to be saved for the fall, winter and spring quarters**. This is because you will have a shorter summer term in comparison with other terms and tuition and fees are lower. For your 4th year it will be important for you to budget financial aid over the entire academic year, rather than quarter by quarter.

Important! Please Note:

We have made a change to campus-based funds awarding for 14-15: To assist you in budgeting for the year, Campus based aid (Grants, Perkins Loans, University Loans, HPL, and LDS loans) will disburse only in the fall, winter and spring quarters in 2014-2015.
