## Appeal to Use 2023 Parental\* Income Information for the 2024/2025 Academic Year

## Purpose of this form:

Students whose parent(s) have experienced significant changes in income from 2022 to 2023 may appeal to have 2023 tax information utilized instead of 2022 for calculation of institutional funding eligibility.

## To submit your appeal:

- 1. Complete this form.
- 2. Submit this form along with a copy of your parent(s) 2023 completed tax return(s). Appeals will not be considered without completed tax returns.
